1. Establishment of a "Science Park" in the Vidyalaya Campus

The College of Education proposes to establish a "Science Park" in the Vidyalaya Campus to promote experiential learning through hands-on engagement with concepts across a broad spectrum of disciplines in Science and Mathematics. The park envisions an inclusive space featuring 50 interactive and accessible exhibits that cater to students of all abilities, including those with special needs, thereby ensuring equal learning opportunities for the entire student community and the general public. It aims to bridge theory and practice, stimulate interest in STEM fields, encourage interdisciplinary learning through themed zones, and foster creativity, curiosity and critical thinking in an engaging and sustainable environment.

2. Conduct of a MOOC-Based Online Course on "Stimulation of Analytical Thinking through Mathematics"

The College of Education plans to design an online course similar to a MOOC on "Stimulation of Analytical Thinking through Mathematics" for students of Grades VI to IX. The course will include 200 interactive video lessons focused on enhancing analytical reasoning and problem-solving skills. Students will be assessed and graded based on online quizzes and examinations, ensuring continuous and comprehensive evaluation. As a long-term initiative, the development and implementation of the course will require considerable time and sustained effort to achieve its intended outcomes.

3. Workshop on Statistical Analysis Using SPSS in Research

The College of Education plans to organise a workshop on "Statistical Analysis Using SPSS in Research" to enhance the research and analytical competencies of postgraduate students, research scholars and faculty members. The workshop aims to provide hands-on training in data analysis using SPSS and advanced statistical methods, enabling participants to apply appropriate analytical tools effectively and build confidence in conducting evidence-based research.

Agenda 6: Any other matter

The members of the IQAC Advisory Committee contributed valuable insights and proposed the following suggestions and recommendations for strengthening the IQAC activities in the college.

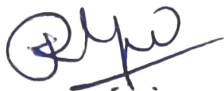
Agenda 6: Any other matter
